### **Our Persecuted Brothers and Sisters**

**Nigeria** - Fulani herdsmen continue their attacks against Christians in northern Nigeria, specifically targeting pastors. Pastor Silas was talking with a church security guard after choir practice when Fulani Muslims attacked, killing the pastor and wounding the guard. In a separate incident, Fulani raiders killed the Rev. Vincent Damina as he fled an attack on his church. In another attack, Pastor Jacob Magit's wife and six of his church members were killed in an attack on his church. As a result of ceaseless attacks throughout the year, about 7,500 people are now living in area camps for internally displaced people. Pray for those who have lost family members or been injured in these attacks. Pray also for aid workers.

**Central African Republic** is #35 on the 2018 Open Doors persecution watch list. While the Central African Republic boasts a Christian majority, there is a significant Muslim minority, particularly in the northeast. The militant Seleka group has mobilized formerly marginalized Muslims to fight against the anti-Balaka militant group comprised of animists and nominal Christians. This conflict has been a source of persecution for Christians who face attacks mainly from the Seleka, but also from the anti-Balaka.
